On the occasion of its General Assembly the Coalition for Energy Savings invites high-level EU and national decision-makers and stakeholders to discuss the shaping of a European climate and energy package for 2030.

How can the 2030 package secure the transition to an environmentally sustainable energy system and respond credibly to the challenges arising from unemployment and energy cost?

The Coalition, which brings together business, civil society, professional, local authority and trade union associations, is making the case for prioritising energy efficiency and that this translates into an energy savings target as part of a comprehensive set of mutually reinforcing targets. Others, however, suggest that this would be premature and that a GHG target might be sufficient to deliver the desired results.
